



## RT-130 TRAINING SHEET

Annual Fireline Safety Refresher Training is designed to provide up-to-date fire line safety information to employees holding Incident Command System qualifications requiring this training per the PMS 310-1, Wildland Fire Qualification System Guide.

This training is divided into 4 main training components: entrapment avoidance, current issues, fire shelter deployment, and other hazards and potential issues. However, each agency can add other training materials as needed per their departmental requirements.
